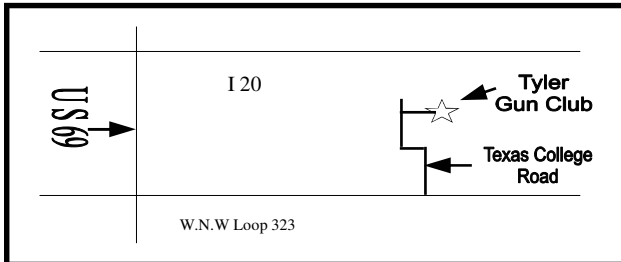
Contestants will be allowed to shoot for targets only and be eligible for trophies. The club is not responsible in case of accident or theft. A.T.A. rules will govern all points not covered in this program. The management reserves the right to postpone or call off any event because of weather or other causes. The management reserves the right to refuse the entry of, or disqualify any shooter who in its opinion is interfering with the harmony of this shoot. In the event of withdrawals after an event has started, shooter's target and trophy money only will be refunded. All purse and option money will be forfeited. All events must be paid in advance. No squad position is guaranteed until the event entry is paid. All optional purses & refunds will be paid by check. Shooters may not win more than one award in each event. All special category shooters (Lady, Jr. Vet.) must mark their card at time of entry. A cashier's sheet showing shooters playing options will be posted for all events. Purse or option money ties divide. If there are less than five entries in any purse or option, one money will be paid. Contestants will forfeit trophies/merchandise should they leave the grounds or not be on hand for a shoot-off. Any trophies/merchandise not picked up by the end of shoot will be forfeited. **No alcoholic beverages are permitted on trap fields or shooting areas. (TGC and A.T.A. Rules) All Firearms will have the actions open at all times except when in gun racks or on the firing line. Note: Juniors may shoot all events for \$18.00 per 100 targets if no options are played. There must be at least three entries in a special category for trophies to be given in that category.**

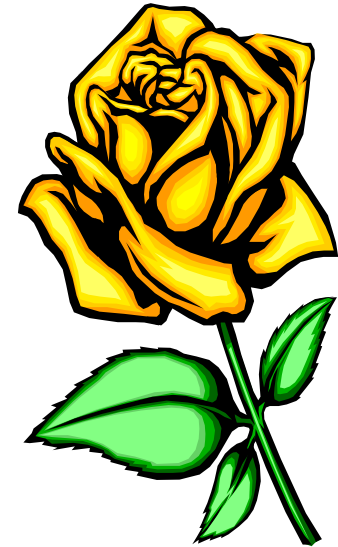
